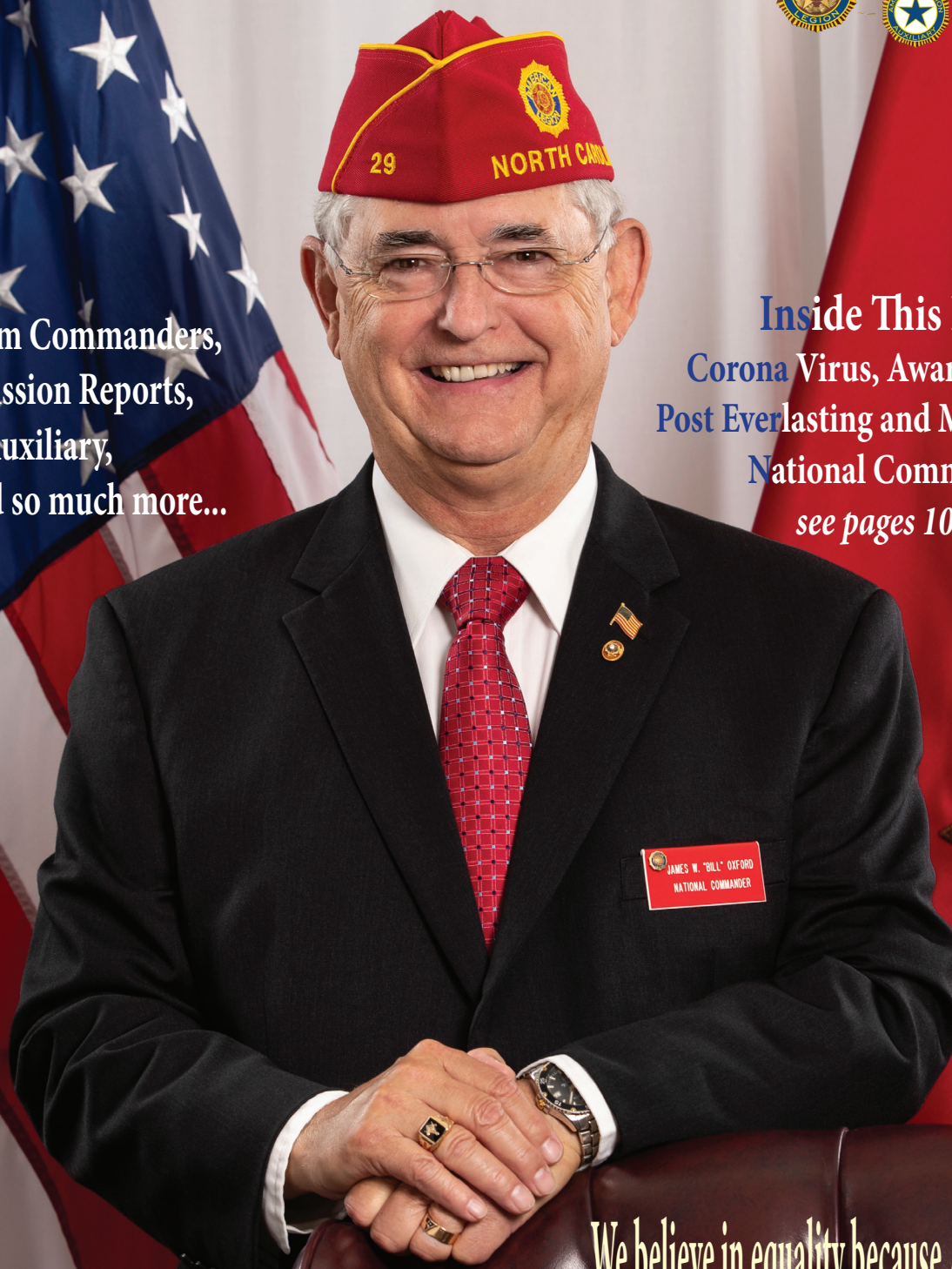

We continue to work from home, and I am one of the fortunate that can work from home and perform most of my responsibilities.

By now, all Posts have received copies of our Proposed 2020-2021 Department of Oregon Budget and Supplemental Budget for August and September 2020.

The Supplemental Budget for the two months was necessary as we changed our Tax Reporting Year from August 1 to July 31 each year to October 1 to September 30 to support reporting our programs. This reporting year change will be the only year we will have to report a short reporting period for the next ten reporting periods. We discussed this tax year move for the past few years, the Department Executive Committee (DEC) approved it and accepted by the IRS.

Just a reminder, those that have not filed your Post Tax's, if your Tax Year is January 1 to December 31, IRS has moved out 990 reporting to July 15, the same as 1040 reporting. For all other 990 reporting periods, the organization has five months after the end of their reporting period to file their Form 990, 990-EZ, 990-PF, 990-N (e-Postcard). Under a new ruling, the IRS was to send a new warning letter to those 501 organizations starting the first year, late or failed to report, and not wait for three years.

As a reminder, please check with your Post and make sure that they have filed their Tax, if questions, we are always available to assist. With the current situation, stay, and working from home, the IRS has a lot of new activity, stimulus payments, care act, it is supporting a lot, and some activity will take longer. Again, a reminder: If your Post receives an IRS Letter revoking your Post EIN because of failure to file Tax's in the past three years, there is a new simplified process to reinstate your EIN. If you file it within 15 months after receiving your IRS revocation letter, there is also a process for restoring your EIN if your Post waited, and it is longer than 15 months. Remember, there are no exceptions, all Posts must file.

It is a new year, and things are much different than the last. The COVID-19 will ever change how our Post's function and operate their clubs. Because of changes, we are going to incur a few more cost's that we may not think we would have, which could cause a financial burden on the Posts and Clubs.

Our posts have done well to weather the confusion and chaos created by the pandemic. Much of our Legion business activities - be it with programs, work on membership, or efforts to provide veteran services within our posts and communities - was disrupted significantly for some time as expected.

However, posts are continuing to adapt to restrictions and constraints and are working to develop means to re-engage their membership. Some Posts are now meeting via social meeting platforms, such as Zoom, while others are conducting in-person meetings and maintaining social distancing measures.

As quickly as our business year ended, the 2020-2021 year is getting underway! I commend the leadership of our posts for persevering through the challenges we face. And, I challenge each of you to continue adapting and ensure our programs are delivered and take care of our veterans.

The membership year concluded with District 1 finishing at 90%. I urge posts to review the year-end membership report for their Post and our District as it very clearly describes where our efforts are needed this next year. With the year just ending, we were 317 members shy of making our goal, and, unfortunately, we were 72 members fewer than this time last year.

We did an excellent job of working the DMS/114 lists for transfers into our posts. We transferred 113 into new post homes - well done! In the new year upon us, we must continue that effort, as well as emphasize member retention. The key is in member retention because we are losing far too many members to non-renewal. We do have the potential to be goal posts and a goal district.

We achieved a 100% completion rate on the Consolidated Post Reports for the District. Again, thank you! We must tell the story of the great work you do within your Post and communities. It is also vital that you share among your members what your accomplishments were for the year. That is a powerful message! Use that message as a springboard into the new year, and garner support and more volunteers to strengthen your communities further.

Incoming district leadership is already working on the locations and dates for district meetings for the upcoming year, so stay tuned for that announcement.

Lastly, I extend my heartfelt gratitude to you all for your support these past two years. It was an honor to represent you at our department executive committee meetings as well as to work with you within our District. Thank you for your support to your Post, to our District, and, to our Department. We can accomplish much, much more when working together.

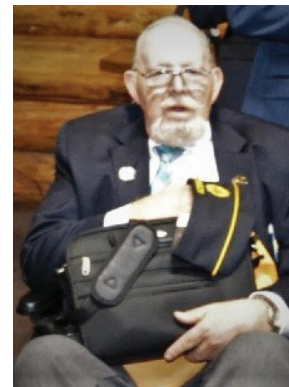

3) The expired list. Re-signing up those members who haven't paid their dues for a couple of years is like low hanging fruit. The same thing applies to the DMS and 114'ers if caught before they pay their dues for the new year.

Remember folks you have a lot of sources to pull from, but if you are from a small post and feel like you are at a disadvantage, those numbers don't all have to come from your own Post.

Post Adjutants will be responsible for keeping track of the numbers and forwarding them to the Dept. Adjutant for those wishing to work toward this award. The Department Adjutant will be responsible for informing me of the names of the two Legionnaires with the most members over 25 to their credit. If numbers are significant enough, I will award \$50 to the second place holder.

For those who might be concerned about the money, this will come entirely out of Sharon and I's pocket. No funds will be taken from the Department or the Membership budget. While we are sponsoring this, the PDC's are in full support and will be the monitors of the program in future years.

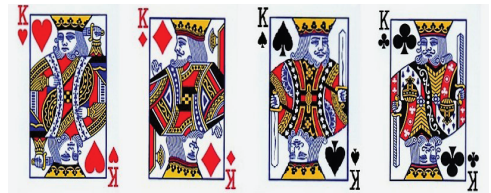

Permanent Finance

Recently the DEC held a special session to take care of some business concerning the Department Convention. During this session, there arose several questions about the funds that "should" be available for redistribution.

Hopefully, this will help clear up a few of those misunderstandings. One: the budget that was under discussion was for our 2020-2021 budget. Not the current budget we are under right now. Two: Why not use money that is not going to be used for things like Boys State, Baseball, Law Enforcement Career Camp, etc. The simple reason is that money is not physically there. The income stated on the budget is what the Permanent Finance Commission (PFC) "projected" the revenue from those programs. As those programs were canceled, there wasn't any income.

What the budget shows in these cases is how much funding was expected and how much the programs were allocated to spend.

When dealing with a "budget," it is easy to get sidetracked because of fiscal years and probable income and expenses. But rest assured that the PFC is acting only in the best interest of the Department of Oregon. It is not the PFC's money; it is all our money.

While discussion of a possible increase in Department dues has taken place, it is only that, at this time, a discussion. Declining membership, which is where the majority of our funds come from, means declining revenue. With everything in the word rising in cost, and our revenue falling, it is prudent that the PFC discusses different scenarios dealing with the future Department Budget. The PFC does not want to recommend a dues hike anymore that our members want to see one.

I hope this helps understand how the budget operates and that what you see on it may be different than what you think it should be. If you have further questions, please contact any member of the PFC for more information.

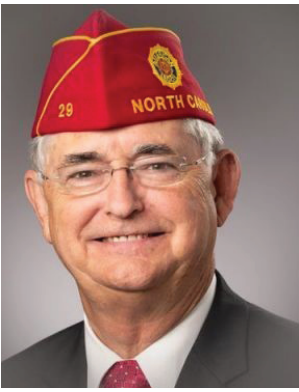

Imagine the absurdity of an argument that states that the Department of Education employs too many ex-teachers. Or that the Center for Disease Control has too many doctors. That was my reaction to the recent War on the Rocks commentary ["Is Veterans' Preference Bad for the National Security Workforce?"](#)

The authors' primary objection to veterans' preference seems to be rooted in their desire to maintain civilian control of the military. Indeed, Article II, Section 2, of the U.S. Constitution states among many other powers, ["The President shall be Commander in Chief of the Army and Navy of the United States..."](#) But the framers recognized the difference between an active-duty soldier and a veteran or else they would have found someone other than a former general to practically anoint as our first president.

While most Americans approve of President Washington's performance in office, it is not senior officers who benefit from veterans' preference anyway. It's the junior enlisted, NCOs and company grade officers. When I left the Marine Corps as sergeant, I could have benefited from veterans' preference. When I later retired from the North Carolina National Guard as a colonel, I could not. Unless one incurs a service-connected disability, retired field grade and flag officers are ineligible. But this isn't about taking care of the top brass. It's about the troops. Who better to serve the U.S. government than those who at some time in their lives pledged a willingness to die for it?

Lost in the civilian control of the military argument is the simple fact that with the exception of those still in the service, veterans are civilians. Those that are in the military already have fulltime jobs.

In spite of unfair stereotypes of veterans as war-mongers, it is Dwight D. Eisenhower who said, "I hate war as only a soldier who has lived it can, only as one who has seen its brutality, its futility, its stupidity." And it is still our elected officials rather than our federal workers who determine if or when military force should be used.

As the nation's largest veterans' organization, The American Legion has a long history of advocating for the occupational and educational advancement of those who answered our country's call. At our national convention in 2016, delegates unanimously passed [Resolution No. 358, "Support for Veterans' Preference in Public Employment."](#)

Our delegates proudly went on record stating, in part, "That The American Legion deplors each and every attempt to degrade, dilute, or modify the historical precedence of giving job eligibility preference to those who are taken from their communities to serve their country in time of war..."

The delegates further resolved, "That all executives at every level of government are urged to enforce veterans' preference in their government agencies."

During a time when the military was almost entirely male, [Alexander Hamilton said, "Justice and humanity forbid the abandoning to want and misery men who have spent their best years in the military service of a country or who in that service had contracted infirmities which disqualify them to earn their bread in other modes."](#)

It is in this spirit [that additional veterans' preference points and benefits are awarded to those who incur a 30-percent or more disability rating.](#)

While some veterans' preference critics lament that the beneficiaries are mostly male, the solution would be to better incentivize women to join the military. If they do, they would find no better advocate for their interests than [The American Legion.](#)

Our organization recognizes that there are many outstanding civil servants who haven’t served in the military and we have never advocated that veteran-status be the only factor in federal hiring. But it should be an important factor.

According to the [Office of Personnel Management \(OPM\)](#), 69 percent of the federal workforce are not veterans. It is also worth noting that the well-earned veterans’ preference benefit does not apply to Senior Executive Service jobs or executive branch positions for which Senate confirmation is required. Moreover, the legislative and judicial branches are exempt from the Veterans’ Preference Act unless the positions are in the competitive service.

Veterans are already at a disadvantage when it comes to occupational advancement. While serving in the military, young men and women remove themselves from the civilian workforce. Many postpone or cancel opportunities for academic or vocational education. As their former high school or college classmates climb corporate ladders, the military men and women risk life and limb climbing mountains in Afghanistan or dodging explosives in Iraq.

But when their military obligation ends, the experienced veterans are more often than not physically fit, highly disciplined, professional and equipped with a skill set obtained through some of the best training in the world.

There is a simple solution for workers who oppose leveling the federal playing field with veterans’ preference policies. They can visit their local recruiting offices, dedicate a few years of their lives to serving their country, and become veterans. They should be warned that the training is challenging and the hardships are numerous. But in the end they will see that the benefits obtained are well-deserved.

Veterans’ preference is a tie-breaker among a pool of qualified applicants. Nobody is suggesting filling air traffic controller positions with truck drivers. But it does make sense to heavily staff the department which sends America’s young people to war with those who have experienced the fight. They earned it.

(INDIANAPOLIS – June 12, 2020) – American Legion National Commander James W. “Bill” Oxford issued the following statement today:

“The American Legion stands on principles and serves purposes worldwide that are violated when justice, freedom and democracy are not applied equally, regardless of race, color, creed or class. These principles formed the foundation of the organization over a century ago, in a very different and deeply divided time in U.S. society. As our nation grieves and tries to reconcile the unconscionable deaths of African-American citizens George Floyd, Breonna Taylor, Ahmaud Arbery, retired St. Louis Police Capt. David Dorn, Federal Protective Services Officer Patrick Underwood in Oakland, Calif., and others, The American Legion stands firm in a value it has upheld, in the form of a national resolution, first adopted 1923:

WHEREAS, The fundamental law of our country guarantees to all peoples equal rights and equal opportunities and the right to worship their God as they see fit; and...

WHEREAS, Membership of The American Legion is made up of those who served our country in a time of great national stress, without distinction as to race, color, creed or class; and...

RESOLVED, ...That we consider any individual, group of individuals, or organizations, which creates, or fosters racial, religious or class strife among our people, or which takes into their own hands the enforcement of law, deter-

mination of guilt, or infliction of punishment, to be un-American, a menace to our liberties, and destructive to our fundamental law; and be it finally

RESOLVED, That we consider such actions by any individual, groups, or organizations, to be inconsistent with the ideals and purposes of The American Legion.

“This resolution’s place in The American Legion’s conscience is so timeless it was reaffirmed, in full, at the organization’s 99th National Convention in 2017.

“Throughout its history, The American Legion has fought to improve racial equality not only for veterans, but for the communities they serve. In 1919, African-American veterans of World War I were among the organization’s founders who adopted a mission statement – the Preamble to The American Legion Constitution – that pledges among other things ‘to maintain law and order,’ ‘promote peace and goodwill on earth’ and ‘safeguard and transmit to posterity the principles of justice, freedom and democracy.’

“Where the law has been broken, justice must be served. Where freedom has been denied, it must be returned, without prejudice. Our nation has much to consider as we continue to strive toward a shared goal found in the Pledge of Allegiance to our flag: ‘with liberty and justice for all.’ All means all. Anything less than complete equality in the execution of these values today is as un-American now as it was in 1923.”

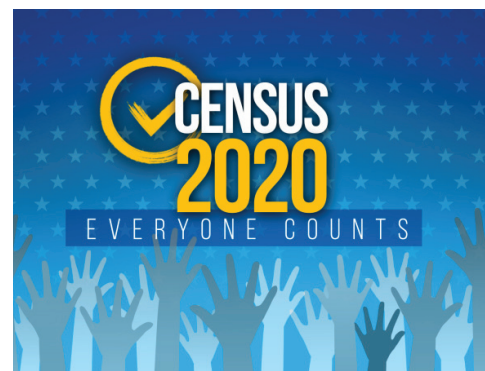

Trump unveils 'bold' plan to prevent veteran suicide, but critics say it's not enough

President Donald Trump praised his new plan to prevent veteran suicide Wednesday as unprecedented, bold action against the problem — but critics argue it isn't enough.

Trump unveiled the plan, which was three months overdue, in the White House on Wednesday afternoon, surrounded by Department of Veterans Affairs officials and veterans advocates. The plan is the result of an executive order Trump signed March 5, 2019, creating a Cabinet-level task force titled PREVENTS, short for “President’s Roadmap to Empower Veterans and End a National Tragedy of Suicide.”

The last annual report from the VA showed that suicide among veterans continues to be higher than among the rest of the population, particularly among women. About 20 veterans and members of the National Guard and Reserve die by suicide every day.

The task force issued its 60-page plan, which included 10 recommendations. The recommendations are expected to take two years to fully implement.

The first action will be a national public service announcement, which Trump described as a “historic” campaign to help end the stigma surrounding mental health. Second Lady Karen Pence, mother of a Marine Corps pilot, will be the campaign’s lead ambassador.

The plan also focuses on improved research into veteran suicide, increased suicide-prevention training and new partnerships between government agencies and outside organizations. It includes a legislative proposal that would establish a federal grant program to fund state and local groups that help veterans.

“We’re gathered to address an especially urgent struggle,” Trump said. “Today, we’re unveiling our roadmap to empower veterans and end the national tragedy of suicide.”

Republican lawmakers praised Trump’s plan, including the GOP leaders of the House and Senate veterans’ affairs committees, Sen. Jerry Moran, R-Kan., and Rep. Phil Roe, R-Tenn.

“We must do more to change the culture and conversation surrounding suicide in the public and private sectors and, most importantly, in neighborhoods

across the country where the real healing work must start and end,” Roe said in a statement. “The PREVENTS roadmap shows us how, and I am confident that it will help to save and improve the lives of at-risk veterans and others for years to come.”

Democrats, though, criticized the plan for not being bold enough.

Sen. Jon Tester, D-Mont., ranking member on the Senate Veterans’ Affairs Committee, said the plan was a “necessary step forward,” but “far more” — including policy changes — needs to be done to make a real difference.

Tester and Moran have pushed legislation for over a year that would boost funding to local organizations that help veterans, as well as increase mental health staff, alternative therapies and research at the Department of Veterans Affairs. The bill, the Commander John Scott Hannon Veterans Mental Health Care Improvement Act, also builds into the law an initiative that Trump announced in 2018 to automatically enroll every service-member into VA mental health care for one year when they transition from active duty.

Rep. Mark Takano, D-Calif, chairman of the House Committee on Veterans’ Affairs, was even more critical of the PREVENTS plan, describing it Wednesday as “meek” and “tepid.” He claimed it was developed with little input from veterans service organizations and lawmakers who work on veterans policy.

“Tepid calls for more research, interagency coordination and meek public education campaigns won’t do enough to end this crisis,” Takano said in a statement. “We have much more substantial work to do to prevent veteran suicide and ultimately help save veterans’ lives.”

Karen Pence, along with other senior administration officials who spoke on background Wednesday, said the plan came at an urgent time. The coronavirus pandemic has created more need for a national plan to address suicide, an official said.

"I feel like right now is such an opportune time because we're all dealing with anxiety, we're all dealing with stress," Pence said. "So, if I can do anything as lead ambassador, it's my goal to help take away the stigma around mental health. We want them to know there are people out there who want to help.

There is a way forward."

The VA's budget request for fiscal 2021, released in February, includes \$53.4 million to the **PREVENTS** initiative.

Dunn announced that Joseph Prince, age 61, of Aurora, Colorado was sentenced yesterday to serve 192 months (16 years) in federal prison for health care fraud, conspiracy, payment of illegal kickbacks and gratuities, money laundering, and conflict of interest charges. Prince was also ordered to serve 3 years of supervised release and pay \$18,777,134.68 in restitution to the Veteran's Health Administration. Prince, who appeared at the sentencing hearing free on bond, was remanded at the hearing's conclusion.

During the closure, we had options, prosper, maintain, or slowly die. We chose to use this time to assist where we could. We have dinners at our Post, not currently allowed, so we moved outdoors. March 29th, we held our first drive-through fish fry with proceeds going to our local Meals on Wheels. Our typical dinner drew 60 to 80 diners, this night, 192 meals in 3 hours, and a donation of \$1600. Two weeks later was Good Friday, April 10th. Proceeds would go to our local Food Pantry. A local TV station aired a short story about the event, and we knew we were in trouble. Three hundred nine diners sold in 3 hours, \$2215 in a donation, enough for 6645 meals at the Pantry. Being closed, we needed some income, so two weeks later, we did another drive-thru for the Post. We sold 182 dinners in 3 hours, proving a point. When we link to a local group, promote that link, we are more successful. The community responds positively.

We typically hold a chicken B-B-Que on a Saturday before Memorial Day, picnic areas, tables, or grab and go. We changed it to a drive-thru offering an \$11 dinner, but if you brought a non-perishable food item, you got a \$1 off—the food item to go to the same local food pantry. We also linked up with the Veterans Legacy Group in Alma, OR. to sell their flowers, hanging baskets and bedding plants. Another success. We sold 600 chicken halves in 5.25 hours, and the

Veterans group sold \$2100 in plants and a pickup truckload of food items for the Pantry.

On May 21st, a hit and run driver killed a young man. His father had been laid off from his job the day before, and the home they were to buy was contingent on the father's employment. We decided to make a benefit dinner for the family on Friday, May 29th. We figured it would be significant and filled every square inch of freezer space with fish and fries. We made twenty-two gallons of clam chowder and tubs of slaw. Three hundred seventy meals served in 3 hours. We were given two more commercial fryers the previous week, and It helped what a great time to promote our ideals, helping veterans, children, and community. In five events, we raised over \$12,500.00, provided needed donations and food items, and picked up several new members for the SAL and our Post. We do make a difference.

Post 10 in Albany, Oregon has continued to be busy during COVID-19. Even though we were in Phase I for three months, Post 10 accomplished the following projects:

1. At the request of the Lebanon, Oregon Veterans Home administrators contacted Post 10 requesting help in feeding their staff. The Canteen had been closed and local restaurant personnel requested that Veterans Home staff not eat in their establishments. Post 10 answered the call by providing meals for 130 people plus we provided 500 masks. Post 10's accomplishment was televised plus there was an article in our local newspaper.
 2. We continued to serve members breakfast 7 mornings per week during Phase I observing the governor's mandated instructions.
 3. The ALR conducted approximately 7 escorts, 5 flag lines, plus several drive-by birthday celebrations for veterans, children and the disabled.
 4. In June, the Post and the ALR participated in a drive-by birthday celebration for a 93-year-old WWII veteran. He passed the next morning; the Post, ALR & Honor Guard participated in his graveside service.
 5. The Post conducted a Celebration of Life ceremony in early June.
 6. Beginning July 4th, the Post will conduct monthly Celebration of Lives ceremonies for the community at large. Anyone who has passed during COVID-19 will be honored.
 7. The American Red Cross utilized our Post for 4 -blood drives each month and continue to do so.
 8. For Flag Day our Post conducted an outdoor ceremony teaching those who attended the proper procedure disposal of flags.
 9. For Memorial Day weekend, Post, ALR and SAL members & volunteers decorated approximately 4,000 veterans' graves. On Memorial Day, members and volunteers traveled to two assisted living complexes to blow taps and conduct a flag ceremony. There was an outdoor flag ceremony with taps at the Post.
 10. Post 10 has partnered with the DOT Ranch providing fresh produce, eggs and frozen meat to those veterans who need help. The Post developed a non-perishable food pantry to distribute items along with the fresh produce, eggs and meat. Thus far we are helping to feed 30 people including 8 children.
 11. Weekly Sunday afternoon *BINGO* began on Sunday, June 7th for approximately 30 people. Social distancing and face coverings were not an issue.
- Our Post feels honored to have the ability and the volunteers to continue serving our veterans' community.
