The nominee must be a member in good standing of an Oregon American Legion Post and an American Legion Riders chapter.

Nominations will be evaluated on the scope and impact of a nominee's commitment and the extent to which her/his efforts benefit and provide inspiration to other Riders, Legionnaires, and veterans. This award will be presented at the annual Department of Oregon convention. Details of the Rider's contribution/s are to be attached in letter form.
